



Commission for Certification in Geriatric Pharmacy
Annual Report
October 1, 2011 – September 30, 2012

The Commission for Certification in Geriatric Pharmacy experienced significant growth during the 2011 – 2012 fiscal year.

The number of individuals who took the Certified Geriatric Pharmacist examination was 513. The number of individuals who passed the CGP examination was 421.

The number of new applicants for the CGP examination was 488.

The number of pharmacists who recertified was 167. At the end of the fiscal year, 1,993 active Certified Geriatric Pharmacists were on record.

The total revenue for CCGP was \$471,543 and the total expenses were \$433,548.
